PurposeThis directive transmits to field personnel the overall OSHA/VOSH policy framework for
administering the OSHA Consultation Program and revises and clarifies processes
and procedures for administering and monitoring Consultation Projects.

Specific additional VOSH requirements and procedures are listed in VOSH Program Directive 03-007, which will remain in effect, dealing with Relationship to Enforcement, Hazard Correction and Verification.

This Program Directive is an internal guideline, not a statutory or regulatory rule, and is intended to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Program.

<u>Scope</u> This directive applies specifically to Consultation Services personnel.
