VOSH PROGRAM DIRECTIVE: 02-054B ISSUED: April 28, 2025

SUBJECT: Process Safety Management of Highly Hazardous Chemicals, 1910.119 – Inspection Procedures and Interpretive Guidance

<u>Purpose</u>. This Directive establishes policies, provides clarifications and compliance guidance for to ensure

that uniform procedures will be followed when conducting inspections to enforce the process

safety management of highly hazardous chemicals standard.

This Program Directive is an internal guideline not a statutory or regulatory rule and is intended

to provide instructions to VOSH personnel regarding internal operation of the Virginia

Occupational Safety and Health Program and is solely for the benefit of the program. This
document is not subject to the Virginia Register Act or the Administrative Process Act; it does not

have general application and is not being enforced as having the force of law.

Scope. This directive applies VOSH-wide and especially to all VOSH Safety Compliance and On-site

Consultation personnel.
